Topic:	Where’s Your Smile		
Lesson Title:	Where’s Your Smile Kinder Drawings		
Level:	K, 4/5	Lesson Duration:	20-30 min

Lesson Objectives:

To build relationships that have a foundation of compassion and respect to foster success.

Summary of Tasks / Actions:

1. Students are paired up as “buddies” at the beginning of the school year and will remain together throughout the year.
2. Students will listen to the song, “Where’s Your Smile” from the Grandpa Steve’s Kids CD.
3. In the beginning with this song, Kinders will work with their “buddy” on parts of the face and body. They will work on shapes and drawing. They will draw each other’s faces with their biggest smile. They will continue to identify parts (appropriate) of the body.
4. This process can continue through the school year. When they see their “buddy,” they smile. Or, when they have a bad day, they can refer to the song. For each student, their buddy is used as a positive experience / reward. This also helps with language development.
